



Burn Ban In Effect

The Guadalupe County Commissions Court instituted an outdoor burn ban for Guadalupe County for 90 days starting September 3rd and going through December 1st. The burn ban imposed by the Commissioners Court has specific guidelines for



Welding, cutting, and grinding or any activity that causes a spark



Burning household trash



Burning of other items

The official notification with all the guidelines can be found on the Guadalupe County website here.



The City of Kingsbury has a "trigger" ordinance where a burn ban is in effect in the city limits whenever there is a burn ban issued by the county.



As always, please take precautions and report any fire hazards immediately to the Kingsbury Volunteer Fire Department at 639-4499 or to the Guadalupe Fire Dispatch at 379-1224. To report a fire, please dial 911.





Of the 254 counties in Texas, there are currently 152 that have a burn ban. This is **way** up from 113 last week and leaves 102 counties without a burn ban in the state.

With the November **elections** coming up, here is some important information regarding the election:

Ballot Items:

Depending on your address, items on your ballot may be different. But most people in the Kingsbury area will have the following on their ballot:

Texas Proposition 1, Establish Special Funds for State Technical College System Amendment
Texas Proposition 2, Prohibit Capital Gains Tax on Individuals, Estates, and Trusts Amendment
Texas Proposition 3, Denial of Bail for Certain Violent or Sexual Offenses Punishable as a Felony Amendment
Texas Proposition 4, Allocate Portion of Sales Tax Revenue to Water Fund Amendment
Texas Proposition 5, Property Tax Exemption on Retail Animal Feed Amendment
Texas Proposition 6, Prohibit Taxes on Certain Securities Transactions Amendment
Texas Proposition 7, Establish Homestead Exemption for Surviving Spouses of Veterans Killed by a ServiceConnected Disease Amendment

Texas Proposition 8, Prohibit Estate Taxes and New Taxes on Estate Transfers, Inheritances, and Gifts Amendment

Texas Proposition 9, Authorize \$125,000 Tax Exemption for Tangible Property Used for Income Production

Texas Proposition 10, Property Tax Exemption for Improvements to Homestead Destroyed by Fire Amendment
Texas Proposition 11, Increase Homestead Tax Exemption for Elderly and Disabled Amendment




Pictured below is the Seguin thoroughfare plan with their "Outer Loop" coming up FM2438.



This plan once came up into downtown Kingsbury, but due to changes in Texas law, a property owner can now be removed from an ETJ (extraterritorial jurisdiction which is an area outside of any city's limits) and therefore be removed from their control. Shown below is Seguin's ETJ around Kingsbury (red dot) in tan with the white areas being landowners that have removed their properties from that ETJ.

Another couple of pictures from Denise Imhoff of the kids at the Kingsbury School when she was attending there.


The school closed in the Summer of 1963 so these would have been taken before that.
