Guadalupe County to consider canceling City of Kingsbury election, commissioners to meet

(Seguin) -- The Guadalupe County Commissioner's Court is expected to cancel November's election for the new city of Kingsbury.

The Nov. 3, 2015 election is being cancelled due to the city's three uncontested races. The positions include mayor and two city commissioners. The deadline to file for candidacy was Sept. 2.

The commissioners court will consider not only cancelling the election but declaring the unopposed candidates as elected.

Those candidates include Shirley Anne Nolen for Mayor and Alison Heinemeier and Janet A. Ignasiak for the two commissioner positions.

Also on the agenda is the acknowledgment of the county's financial transparency online. The county has been designated a Texas Comptroller's Leadership Circle Platinum Member Award.

The meeting begins at 10 a.m. today in the Guadalupe County Justice Center.
