### Full Pink Moon

This Monday, April 3rd, is the full moon in April known as the Full Pink Moon.



The Full Pink Moon heralds in the appearance of the “moss pink,” or wild ground **phlox**—one of the first Spring flowers. It has also been known as the Grass Moon, the Egg Moon, and the Fish Moon.

These names were used by early Colonial Americans—who learned the names from the local Native Americans; time was not recorded by using the months of the Julian or Gregorian calendar. Many tribes kept track of time by observing the seasons and lunar months, although there was much variability. The name itself usually described some activity that occurred during that time in their location.

Audra has done an **awesome** job at remodeling the old shed into a great looking space inside and out!



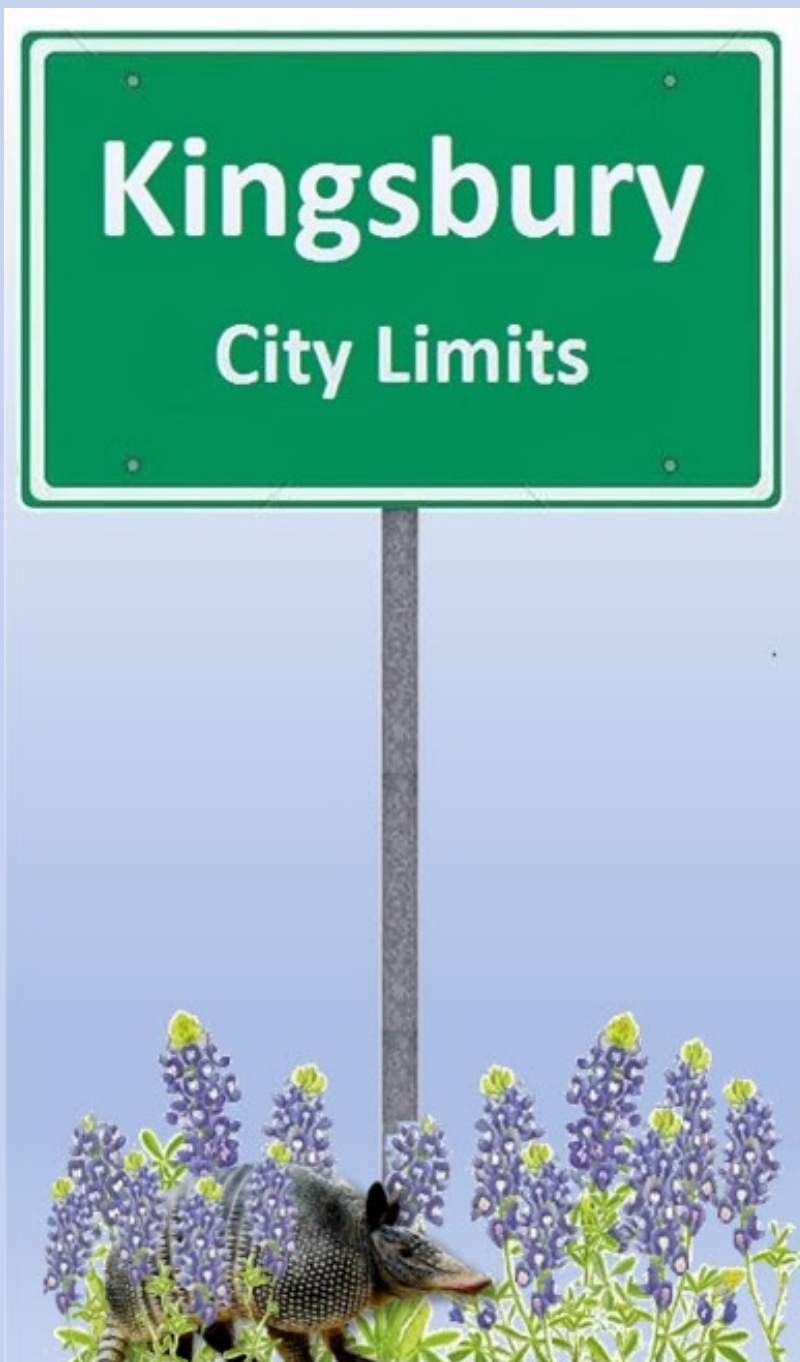
## Kingsbury City Limits

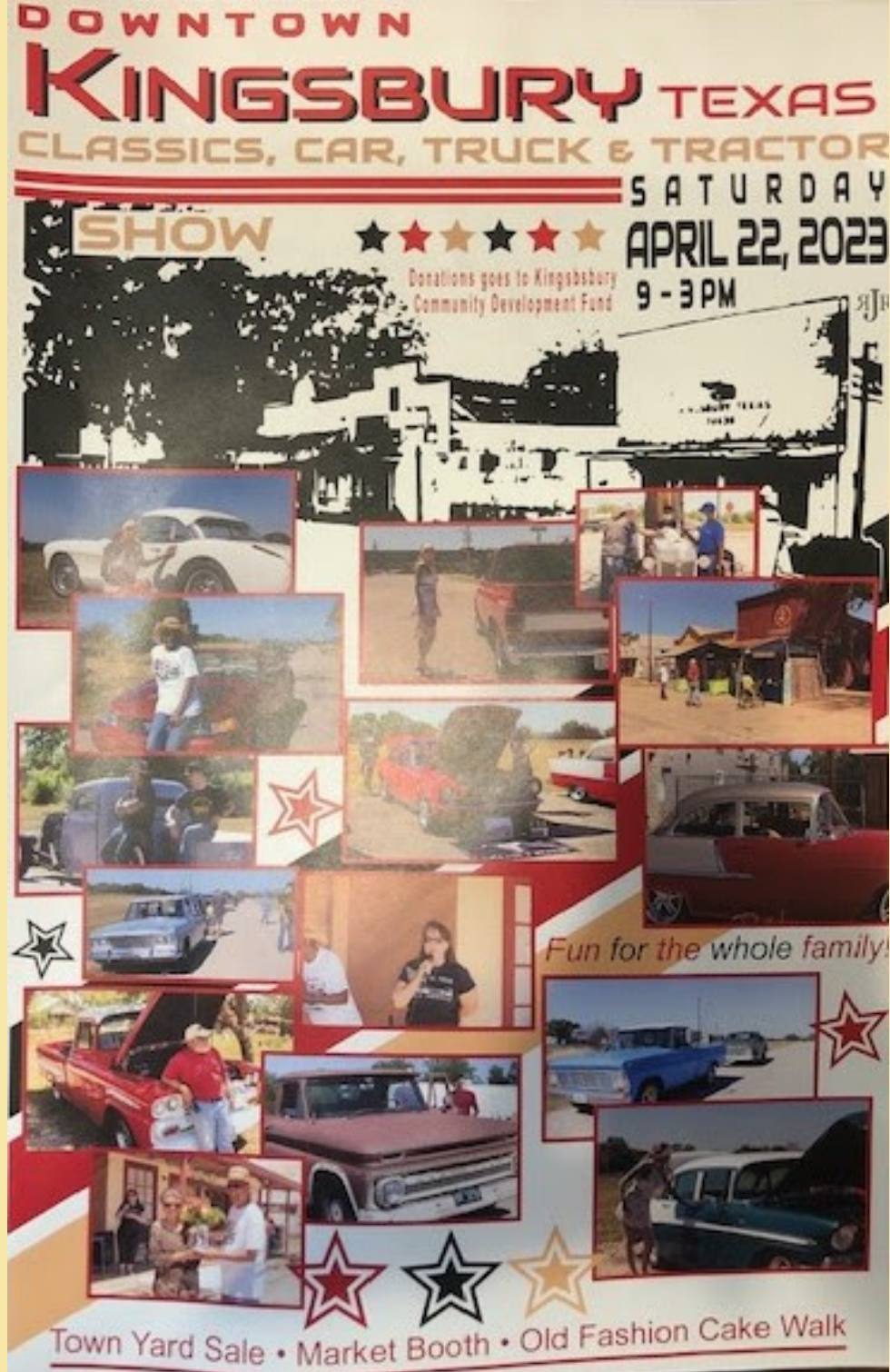

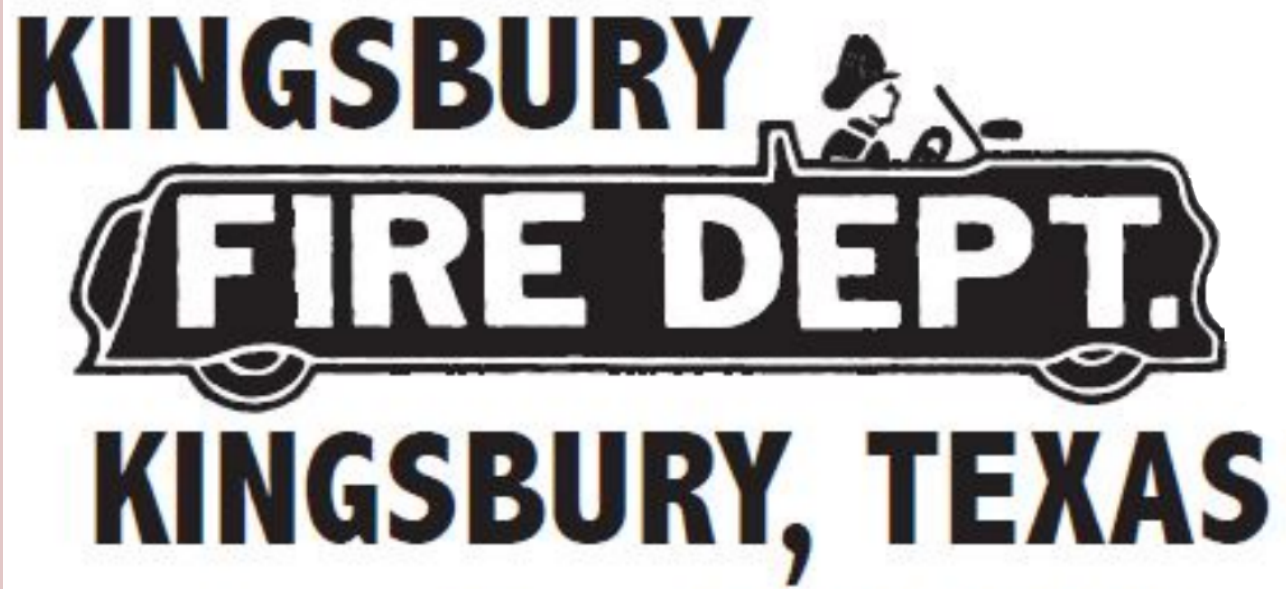
