

**PETITION REQUESTING VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION OF  
TERRITORY BY OWNERS**

To the City Commission of the City of Kingsbury, Texas,

The undersigned owners of the hereinafter described tract of land which is vacant and without residents, or on which less than three (3) qualified voters reside, hereby petition your honorable body to extend the present municipal limits so as to include and annex as a part of the City of Kingsbury, Texas, the property described by metes and bounds on the attached Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes (hereinafter "Property"). If any portion of the Property is appraised for ad valorem tax purposes as agricultural, wildlife management use or timber land under Chapter 23 of the Tax Code, we certify that we waive the requirement to be offered a development agreement pursuant to Section 43.035 of the Local Government Code and that we would decline such agreement if offered and still request annexation. We certify that the Property described in Exhibit "A" is contiguous and adjacent to the City of Kingsbury, Texas, is not more than one-half mile in width, and that this petition is signed and acknowledged by each and every corporation, entity and person owning said land or having an interest in any part thereof.
