Burn Ban In Effect

The Guadalupe County Commissions Court instituted an outdoor burn ban for Guadalupe County for 90 days starting October 2nd. The burn ban imposed by the Commissioners Court has specific guidelines for



Welding, cutting, and grinding or any activity that causes a spark



Burning household trash



Burning of other items

The official notification with all the guidelines can be found on the Guadalupe County website here.



The City of Kingsbury has a "trigger" ordinance where a burn ban is in effect in the city limits whenever there is a burn ban issued by the county.






Of the 254 counties in Texas, there are currently 128 that have a burn ban, way down from 136 last week. This leaves 126 counties without a burn ban in the state.

Current burn bans by county in Texas last week and this week:






Kingsbury City Limits
