Kingsbury Collection Station

The Guadalupe County Commissioners Court at their session this past Tuesday once again addressed the collection/recycling stations in Kingsbury, Marion, and Seguin.

The court reviewed the companies that applied for the contract, the costs related to the centers, the amount of waste and recycling taken in at each center, the rates that would apply to customers, etc. It was decided to go forward with a contract to Republic for running the services, but only **reopen** the Kingsbury and Marion centers.

This means that there is light at the end of the tunnel for reopening the Kingsbury station!

The details will be decided and voted on in coming sessions and a reopening date can then be determined. We'll keep you updated on the changes and the reopening.

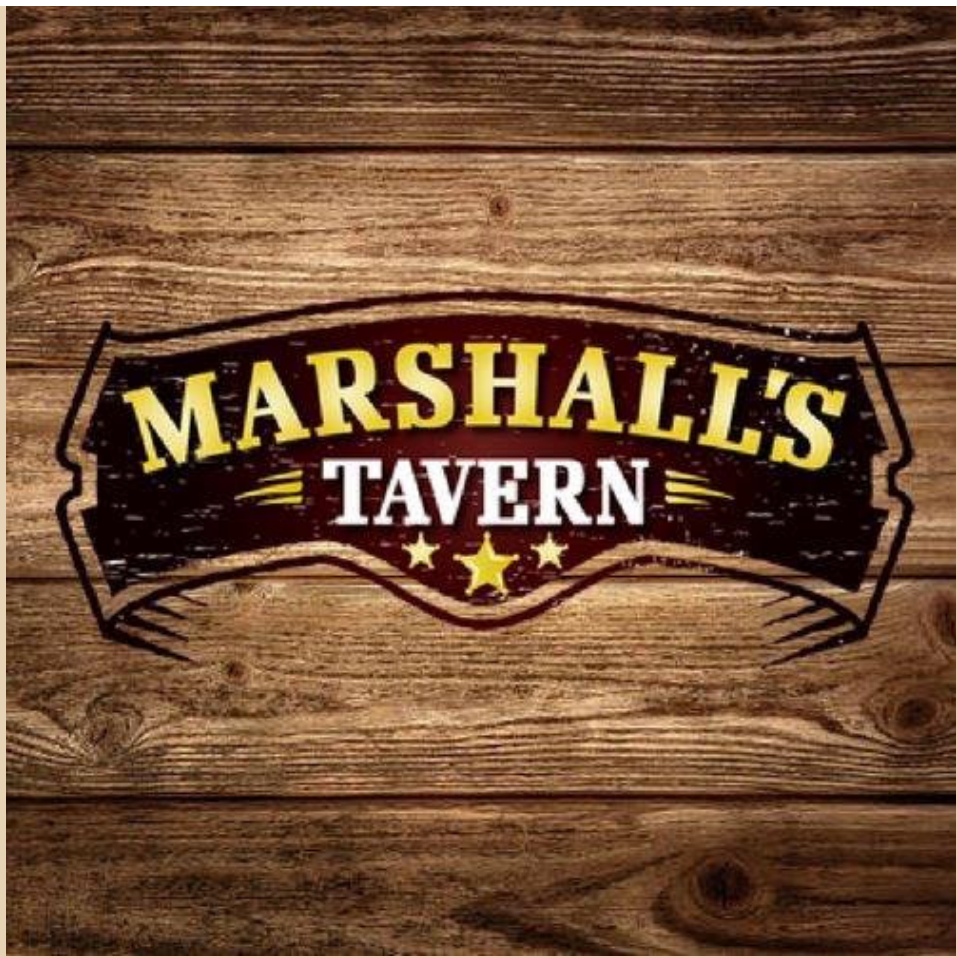


## Marshall's Tavern

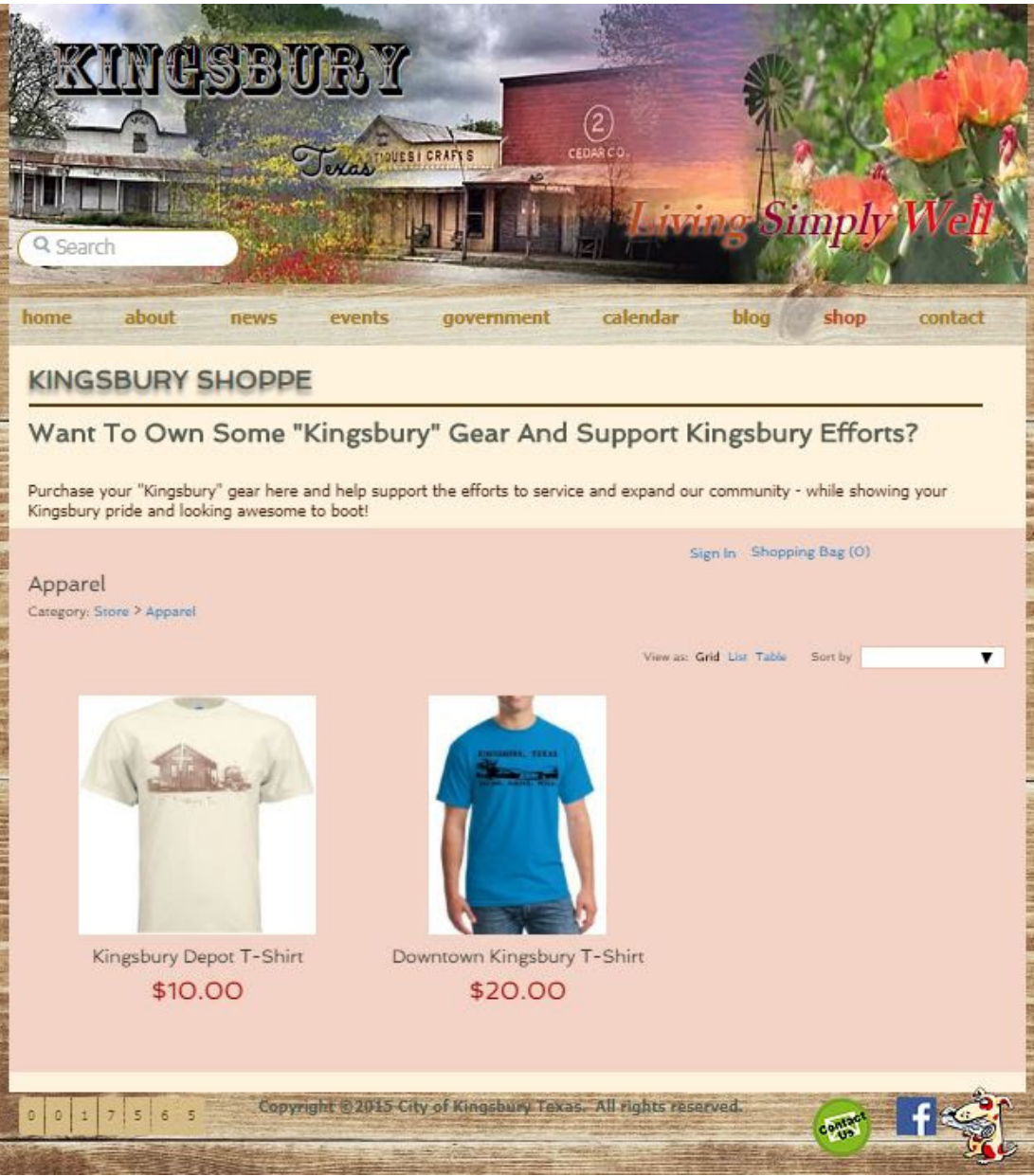
That says it all, doesn't it?!

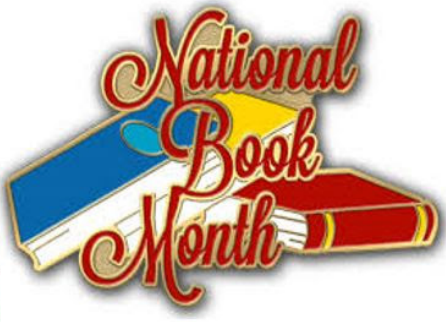

Gates open at 9 am and the entry is free (but donations are gladly accepted!).





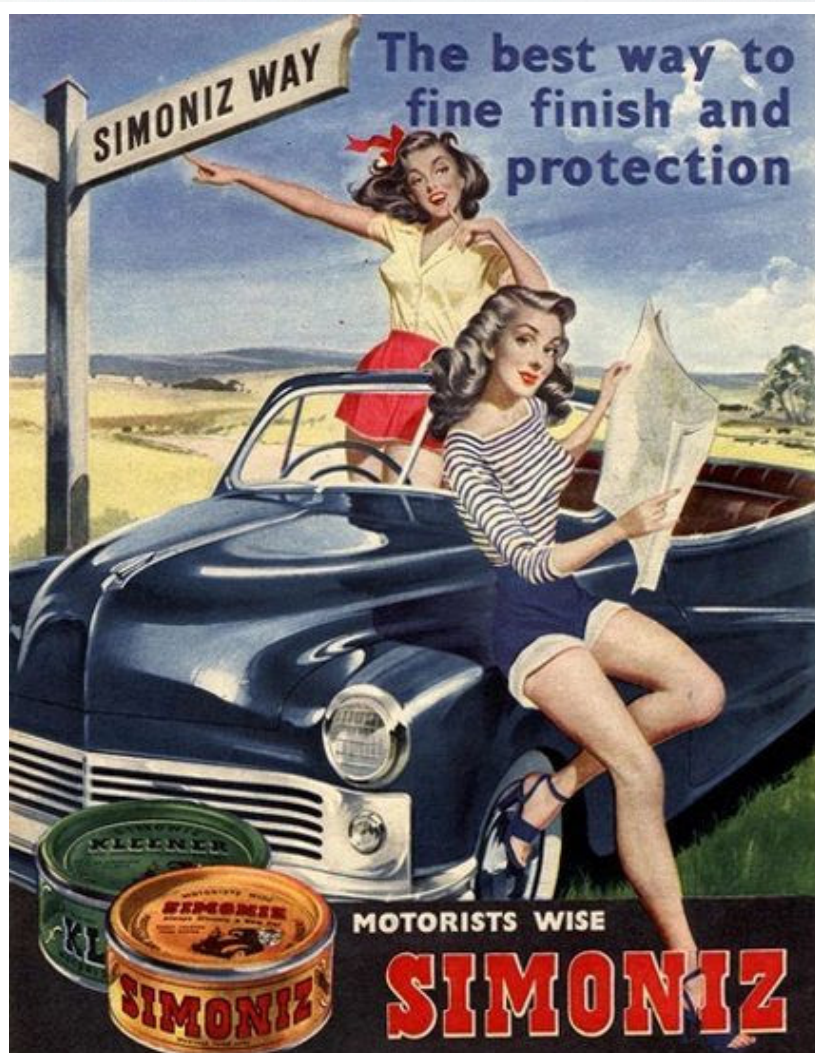
## Hanging Out
