



## MOON FACTS AND FOLKLORE

- 🌕 On February 6, 1971, Alan Shepard became the first man to hit a golf ball on the Moon.
- 🌕 Did you know that the Moon's diameter is 2,160 miles? This is less than the width of the United States (approximately 3,000 miles), and 0.27 of Earth's diameter (7,926 miles).
- 🌕 Wolves have howled at the Moon for centuries, yet it is still there.

Dakotah Sioux - Moon of the Raccoon  
Wishram - Shoulder To Shoulder Around The Fire Moon  
Cherokee - Bony Moon  
Chippewa - Sucker Moon  
Algonquin - Ice In River Is Gone Moon  
Arapaho - Frost Sparkling in the Sun Moon  
Tlingit - Black Bear Moon  
Choctaw - Moon of Winds  
Cree - Old Moon  
Hopi - Moon of Purification and Renewal  
Mohawk - Lateness Moon  
Pueblo - Moon of the Cedar Dust Wind  
Shoshone - Coyote Moon  
Winnebago - Fish-Running Moon

Colonial American - Trapper's Moon  
Celtic - Moon of Ice  
Medieval English - Storm Moon  
Neo Pagan - Snow Moon


