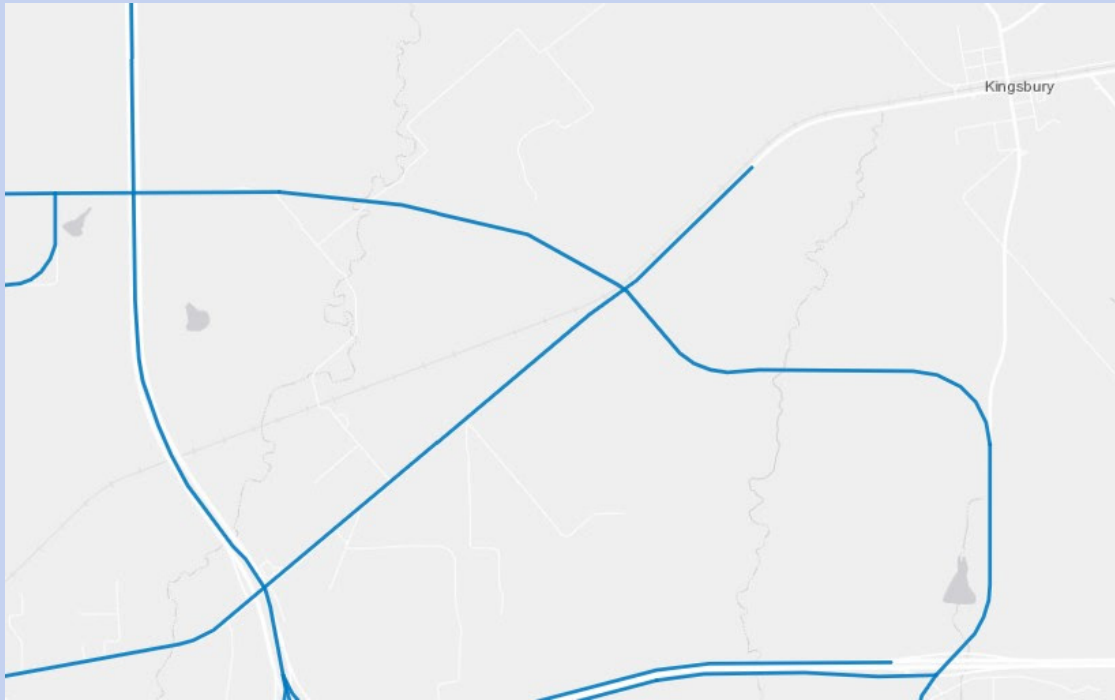
Kingsbury City Limits

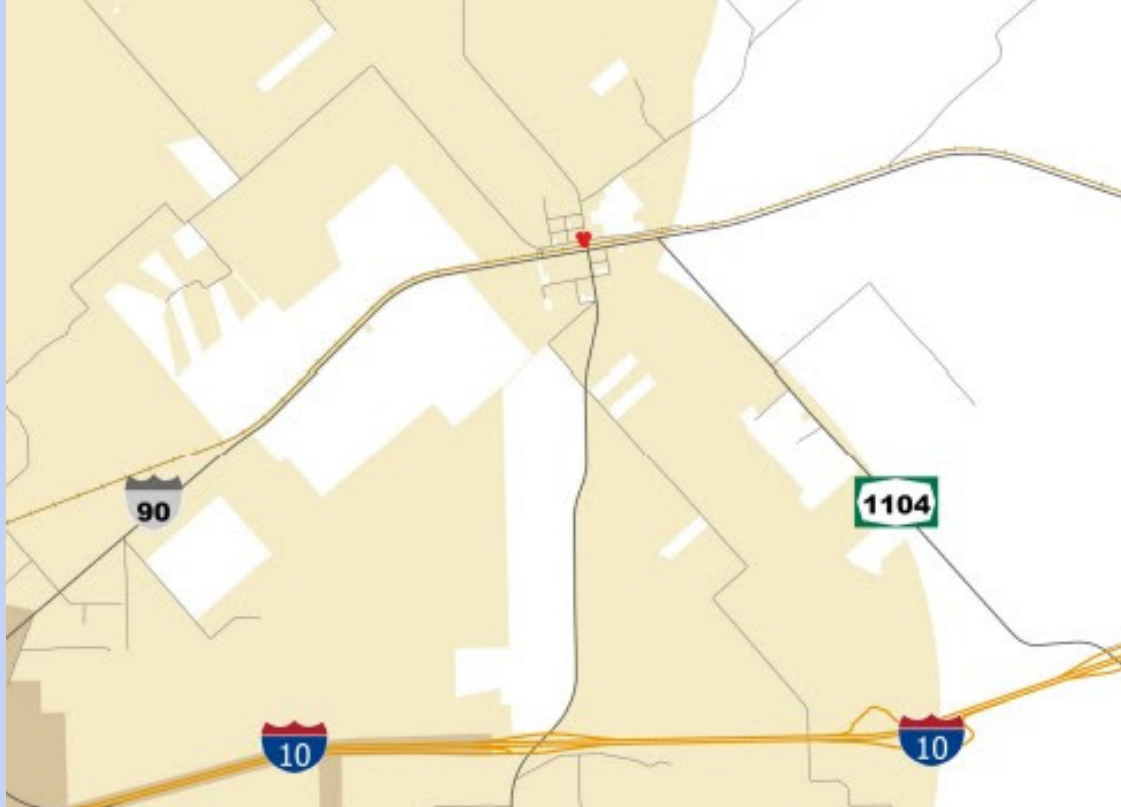

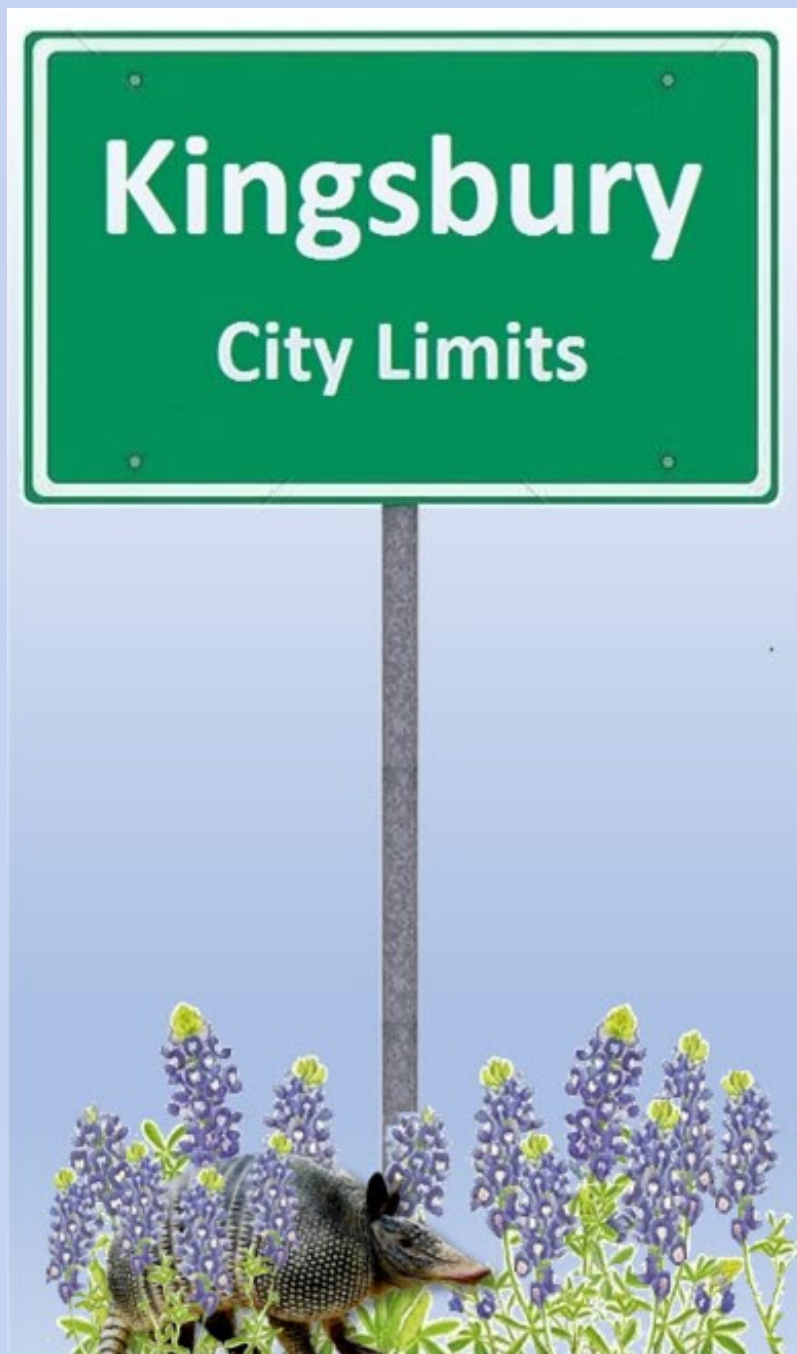
Pictured below is the Seguin thoroughfare plan with their "Outer Loop" coming up FM2438.



This plan once came up into downtown Kingsbury, but due to changes in Texas law, a property owner can now be removed from an ETJ (extraterritorial jurisdiction which is an area outside of any city's limits) and therefore be removed from their control. Shown below is Seguin's ETJ around Kingsbury (red dot) in tan with the white areas being landowners that have removed their properties from that ETJ.

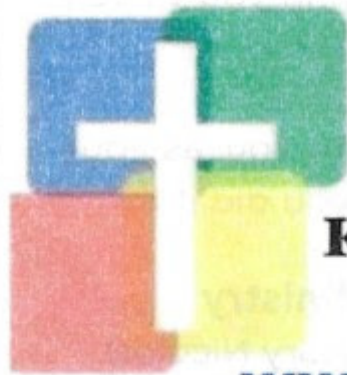

What a wonderful picture of girls and their dog in front of the Halm's Red & White grocery store in downtown Kingsbury in October of 1946.

Leonora Schmidt is holding the little dog and Mary Jane Appling is standing behind her and both girls are all smiles! It looks like a nice summer day with their **sandals** on and cute little dresses.

Red & Whites were a grocery store chain popular in small towns back in the day. The screen doors have a Dr. Pepper push bar and it looks like a thermometer to the right. The window on the left has the Red & White Foods logo and says Groceries and Meats below that. At the bottom of the window is a sign promoting Tschoepe for District Clerk.

The awning front is painted red and white and all of that is still there today, minus the red and white paint. But it's still under there somewhere!
