there are always aircraft and Model T's that need TLC. Please consider joining and helping out!




Pioneer Flight Museum's replica 1924 Dormoy "Bathtub" racer, Simon Driver pilot, on the December 15, 2018 work day.

Gander Slough, Texas - 1923

A picture of Gander Slu, Texas, near Kingsbury and Sullivan in eastern Guadalupe County in 1923. Gander Slu was from 1859 to 1866 the site of a post office called Barrowsdale, after Dr. Leonard Barrow. Oil was discovered in the area in 1922 and Sullivan became a loading site for oil tank railroad cars. The landowner, a Mr. Allen, suggested the name Allensville for the community that grew up around the oilfield, but one of the workers suggested "Gander Slough," a play on the name of the Goose Creek oilfield near Baytown. The worker put up a sign with the spelling "Slu."

The population was twenty-five in 1945, when the settlement included a few houses, a cemetery, and oil pumps.

Gander Slu was not shown on county highway maps in 1987.

In the picture, one of the buildings on the left appears to be a big tent instead of a hard-sided structure. The road in front of it and the OK Cafe is an ugly, sloppy mess! And there are about as many gasoline-powered vehicles trying to traverse the mud as there are horse and **mule** carts.

I think the horses and mules probably won the war with the mud that day!
