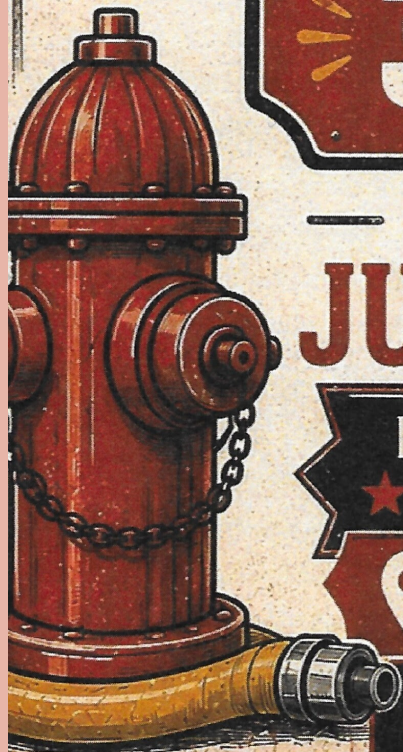

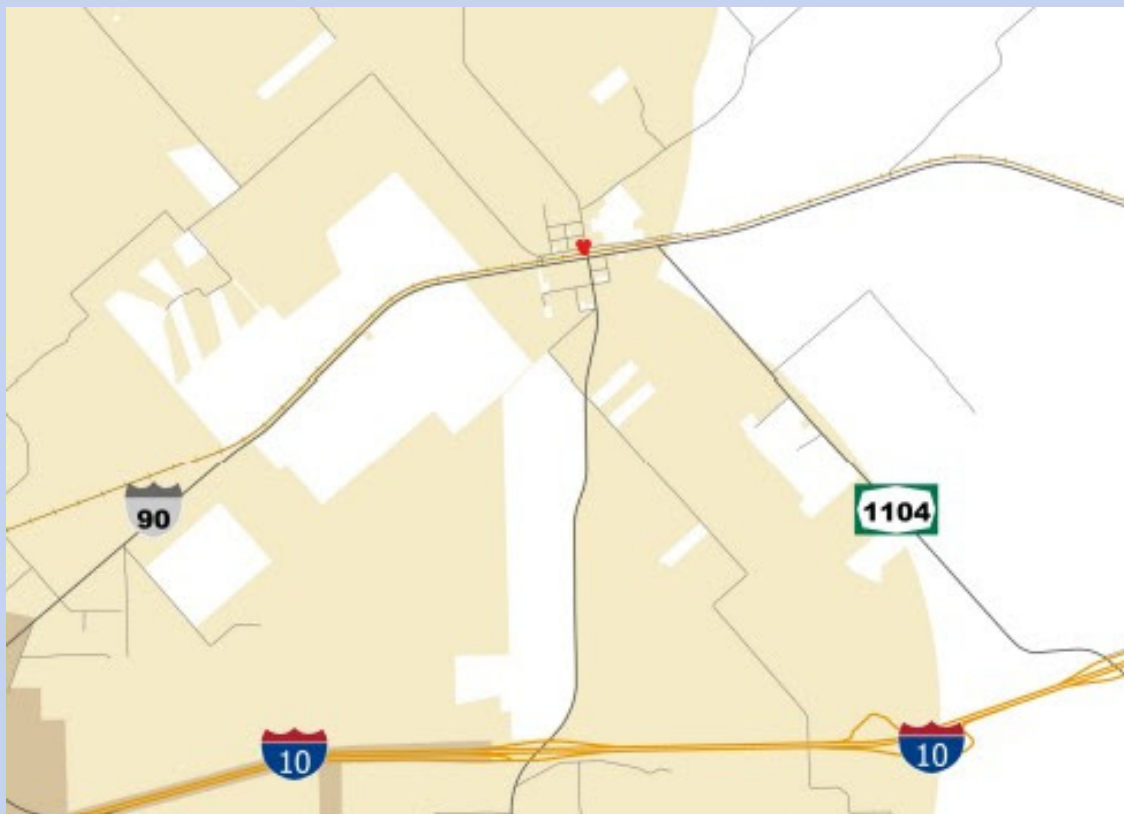

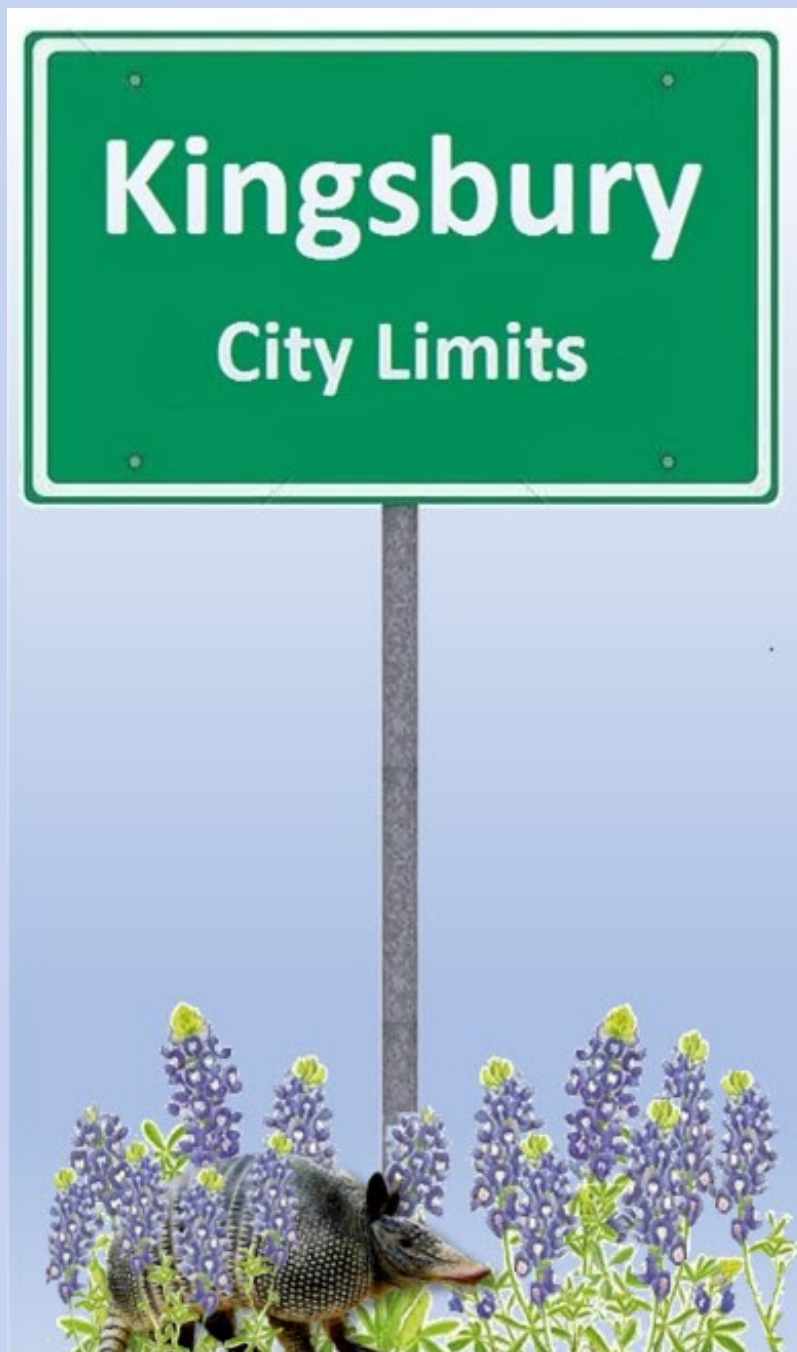
Pictured below is the Seguin thoroughfare plan with their "Outer Loop" coming up FM2438.



This plan once came up into downtown Kingsbury, but due to changes in Texas law, a property owner can now be removed from an ETJ (extraterritorial jurisdiction which is an area outside of any city's limits) and therefore be removed from their control. Shown below is Seguin's ETJ around Kingsbury (red dot) in tan with the white areas being landowners that have removed their properties from that ETJ.

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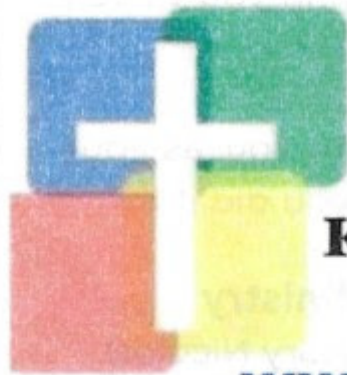

Many people in the Kingsbury area attended the Dowdy School in the Darst Creek oil field area while it operated from 1917 to 1951. The school was located on FM 212 just off of FM 1150 south of Kingsbury.

The picture was obviously taken inside the gymnasium of the school and the boys all look very serious!
