Road Work

You may have seen the sign on Kingsbury Road to expect traffic **delays**.

Guadalupe County Road & Bridge began work two weeks ago to "level up" the roadway beginning on the north end of Kingsbury Road near FM 20 and moving south on the eastern lane. Work is now going from south to north working on the western lane.

Adding a center stripe will only be done once the complete roadway is re-topped.

The road will not be closed, but we can expect long delays where the crews are working. The work will take several more days to complete.

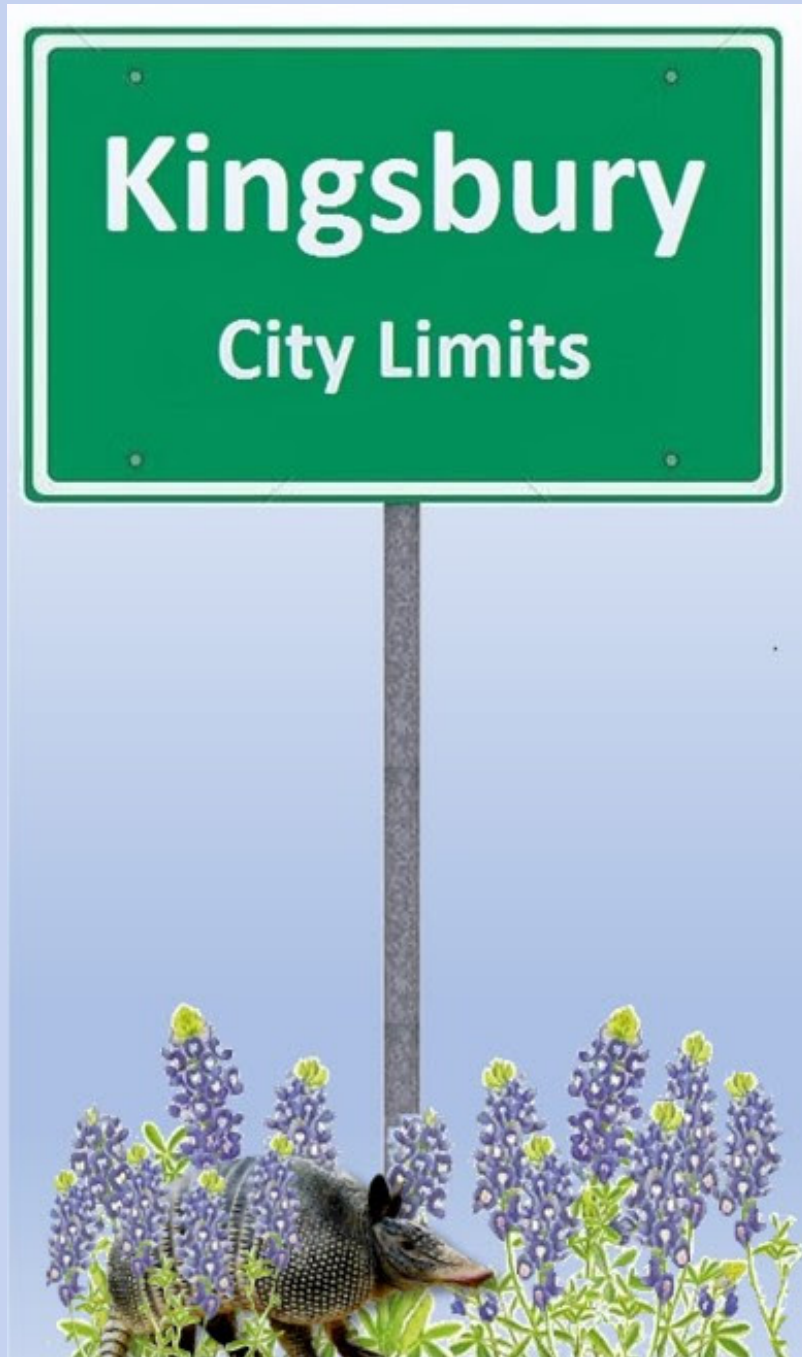
Kingsbury City Limits

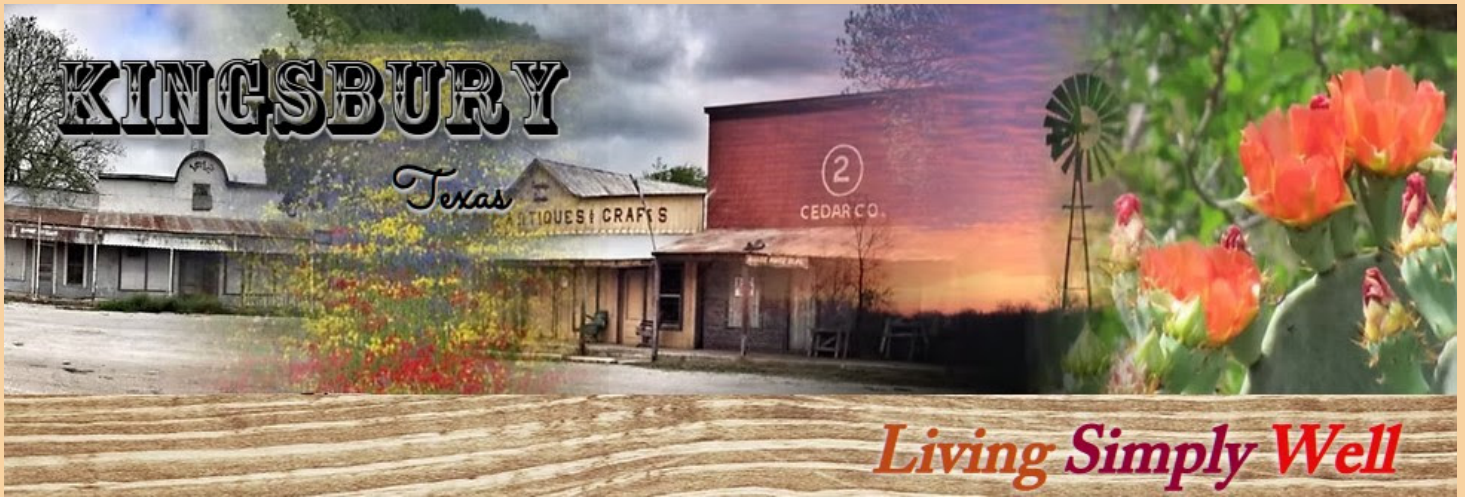
