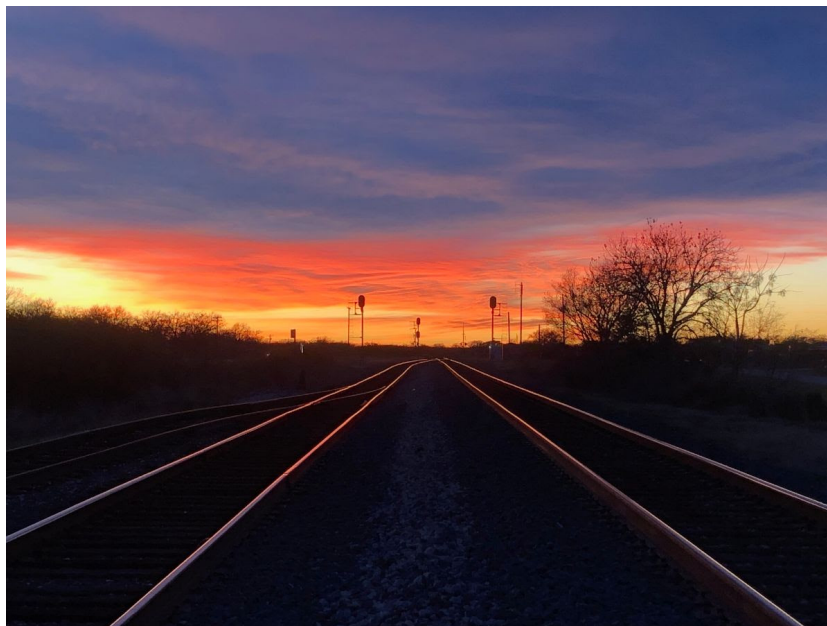

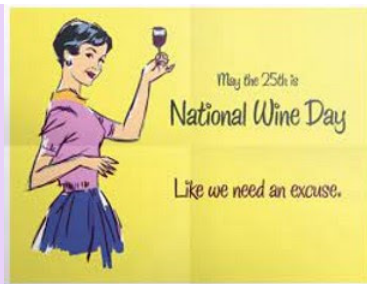

Pick up your delicious food at 935 Mill Creek Road.

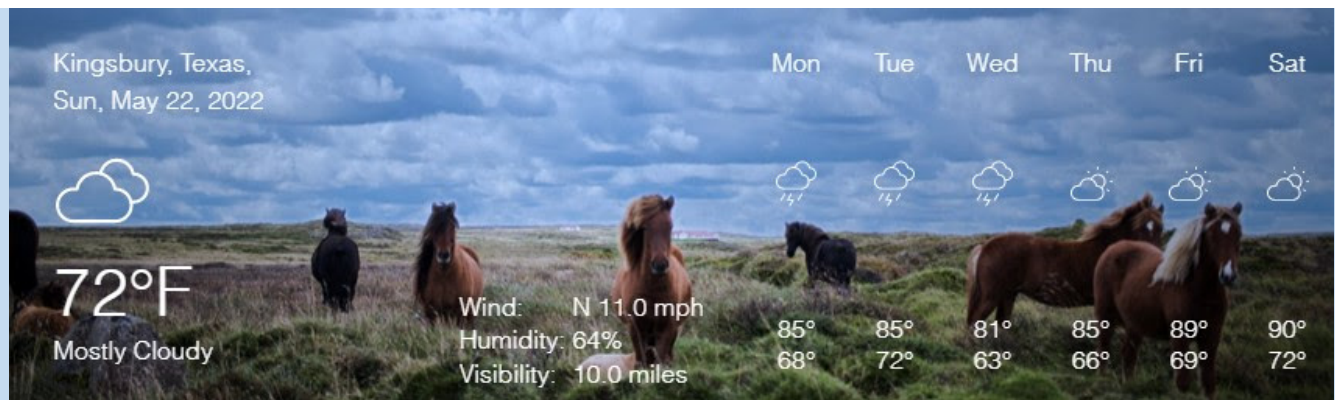

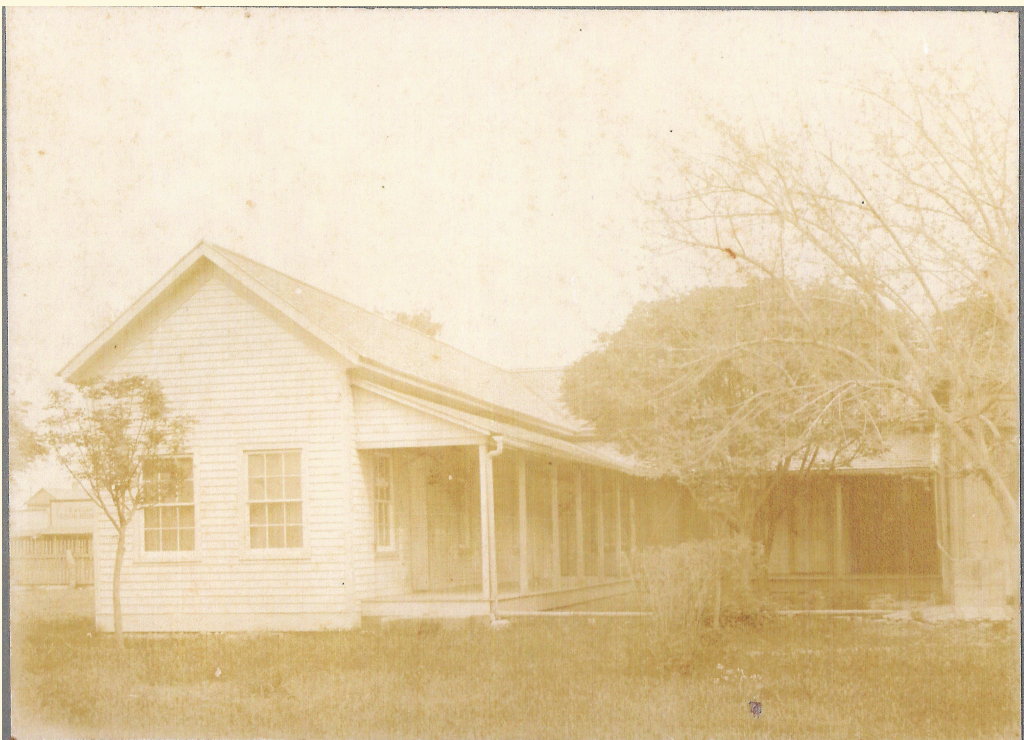

## Wolfshohl Hotel

---

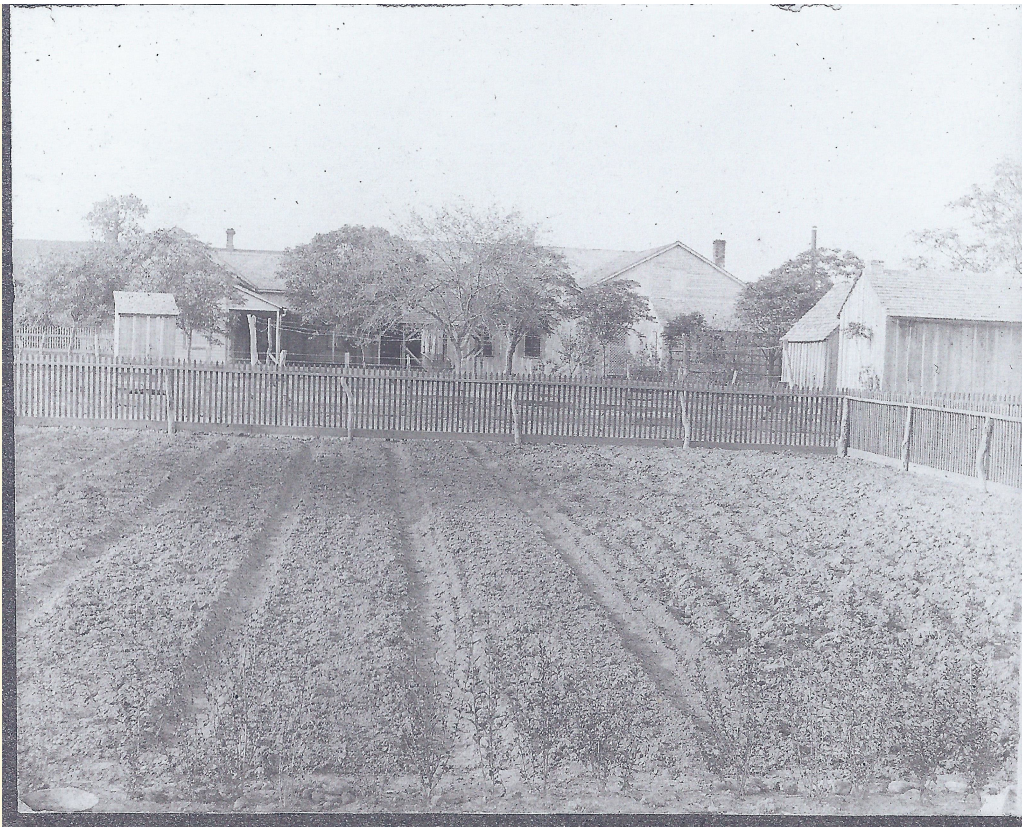
Kingsbury has had several hotels over the years, one being the Wolfshohl Hotel. This hotel was built south of the tracks and the **depot** by the Hampton family and was sold to Daniel Wolfshohl in 1889.

It was used until 1924 when a new hotel was built on the north side of the tracks and called the Lynch Hotel, run by Mrs. Carrie Jones. The pictures below are of the hotel from the front, the back, and the back from across a freshly sewn garden.
